The Alaska Railroad Whistle Stop opens the door to a myriad of remote possibilities—a day trip with many options for hiking, glacier sightseeing and wildlife viewing.

This remote experience is only accessible by way of train. The Spencer Glacier Whistle Stop features a low-impact gravel path with benches and incredible scenic views along the way. Opt to hike alone or join a Chugach National Forest Service Ranger for a fun and informative journey. For more ambitious hikers, there's a 3.4 mile trail that takes you right to the face of the glacier.

Hikers have from 1:45pm to 4:30pm to complete the roundtrip hike and meet the return train. \$103 per person

Ride the rail to Spencer Glacier and steal away on a gentle float tour among the icebergs at Spencer Lake and down the Placer River. Professional guides, raingear, and rubber boots are provided.

Tour departs from Alyeska Resort. A deli-style lunch is included. Tour includes a one-way rail and a return by motorcoach. \$202 per person.
